We invite your comments on issues, opportunities, concerns and suggestions that are related to the Proposed Action described in the Notice of Intent, published on October 1, 2007. The comment period ends November 15, 2007.

Your comments will help us in a number of ways. Any new information you provide will help us produce a better, more informed decision about individual routes and about the overall motorized transportation system. Your comments will be used to help identify important issues about the proposal, which in turn help develop the range of alternatives that will be analyzed in a Draft and Final Environmental Impact Statement. An issue is an effect on physical, biological, social, or economic resources caused by the proposed action.

Comments you made earlier in this process were used in the development of the Proposed Action. The information from those comments will carry into the rest of the process; however, if you feel that any new information will help, you may submit additional comments at this time.

It is important to note that this comment period is not a “voting” exercise. A single comment which raises an important issue will have the same weight as thousands of identical comments. Multiple identical comments provide the Forest with the same identical issue.

Comments should be received in writing – either through the mail or e-mail. Oral comments will only be considered only in very specific and limited forums. While you are encouraged to contact the Travel Management Team through any method to ask questions for clarification, comments made over the phone or in person to a Forest employee cannot be considered a formal comment in the context of this proposal.

This comment sheet is meant for your convenience and will help us collect route-specific input in a consistent way. However, this form is optional, and your comments are welcome in any format if the form does not meet your needs.
